### The Men's Club

The Crown Isle Men's Club is available to all dues paying male members of Crown Isle Golf Club. Part of your membership fees paid to Crown Isle goes towards your dues in the Men's Club. Your Men's Club dues go towards Golf Canada membership, hole-in-one insurance, tournaments and general expenses for running men's club activities.

## Starting up

1. When you have paid your membership fees and if you are a first time member at Crown Isle, the pro-shop staff will enter your name into the Golf Canada Handicapping system.
2. When you have been provided with a user-id and password go to the Golf Canada Handicapping system and update your profile. →
3. If you wish to be put on the men's club directory you must enter your phone number into your profile.
4. If you wish to be put on the men's club email distribution list, also enter your email address into your profile. Note - if you wish to be put on the men's club email distribution list right away, send a note to the **Club Captain**.
5. In order to participate in the men's club events, members must maintain their scores and handicaps in the Golf Canada Handicapping system.
