### 2010 Events

#### ➤ The Crown Isle Cup Competition

The Crown Isle Cup Competition will be running again this year culminating in the Crown Isle Cup Tournament on October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Members can earn points by participating in our various club events

#### ➤ Organized Play (Thursdays & Saturdays)

Men's Club Thursday & Saturday Organized play will be starting April 1<sup>st</sup> this year. This will work essentially the same as last year and members wishing to play must sign-up in the pro-shop at least two days prior.

The schedule for the Thursday and Saturday organized play will be announced at a later date and will be sent out to the members by email. It will also be displayed on the Men's Club Website (see below).

#### ➤ Tuesday Men's Night

Tuesday Men's Night will start up again on April 6<sup>th</sup>. A block of tee-times has been reserved starting at 4:00pm for members and guests of members to play individual prize competitions. Like last year, the competition will be played over the first nine holes. Prize money will be paid out for KP's, hidden holes, skins, and low-net scores.

Members also have the option to book their own tee-times for earlier in the afternoon, turn in their scorecards after the first nine holes, and continue playing the full 18 holes.

After play, members can enjoy the rest of the evening, either in the Timber Room Pub or in the Men's Club Room.

The cost for entering the men's night competition is \$5.00 per person, plus \$5.00 for the skins game.

- Play will be from the Green Tees.
- Competition is played over the first 9 holes. There will be two KP holes
- Prizes will be awarded after play is finished, in cash.
- All players must have a registered RCGA handicap.
