## ➤ Byes

There have been some enquiries as to why there are so many byes in the singles matches. The reason for this is: The original intent was to limit the number of entries in each event to 32 members or teams. However, we received more than the 32 entry limit in the singles events. To accommodate all members who wanted to participate in the match play tournament we opened up the events to allow for the extra entries, causing us to go up to a 64-entry single elimination format. With the number of participants in the Men's Singles at 38 that would require 26 byes in the first round. Byes were assigned to the entrants in the order they signed up (i.e. the earlier signups got the byes, the later ones did not)

## Policy for Organized Play

For Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, foursomes will be filled and will play first, followed by threesomes, to allow for any stragglers that may show up.

For Saturday morning organized play: The time blocks booked for Green Tee Play or Blue Tee Play are reserved for play of the specified event for that day. Members not wishing to play in the specified event should book their own tee times with the pro-shop.

In order to be eligible to play in our men's club tournaments members must have at least 10 scores recorded in the RCGA system for the current year (may include scores played at courses other than Crown Isle).

This denies other members and guests playing opportunities or impacts Crown Isle's revenues from prospective green fee players. Please be considerate when booking times and provide the pro-shop with suitable notice of any cancellation (either full or partial groups).
