Crown Isle Cup Tournament – October 3rd

This year we came up with a new idea (thanks to Kerry Ketter and David Barnes) to encourage our members to participate more in our club events. A mechanism was established whereby members would be awarded points for participating in certain events and for finishing in the money in the Thursday and Saturday organized play events. Members could earn points in two divisions (the Thursday Division & the Saturday Division). The Thursday Division was primarily for seniors playing from the white tees while the Saturday Division was for all members playing from the green or blue tees. Members could earn points in either division by playing in other events such as the Captain's Cup or the Horserace/Calcutta tournaments. Each month the highest point earner would receive prize money. Winter Rules

Winter rules are in effect until March 1st, 2010. As a reminder, here are the rules:

- Through the green: mark, lift, clean and place ball with one club length relief and not nearer the hole.
- This DOES NOT allow you to move the ball from the ROUGH to the fairway.
- You are not entitled to relief under this rule if the ball is at rest in a position where there is interference with your swing or stance from a tree, shrub or rock, or if the ball has come to rest in an unplayable lie.
- And just in case you forgot: "Through the green" is the whole area of the course except:
 - The teeing ground and putting green of the hole being played; and
 - All hazards on the course.
