A major topic of discussion will be the adoption of the new Men's Club Constitution. Following, is the covering letter regarding changes to the constitution:

Our club currently functions under a constitution that last had a major revision on October 10th, 2001, with amendments made October 3rd, 2007. While this document has been most useful in the organization and operation of the club, it was inconsistent in the way some of the sections were formatted. In addition, several sections lacked clarity or required upgrading for the efficient operation of the club. Your current executive committee commissioned a sub committee consisting of Ted Hodkin and Terry Cox from the Executive Committee and Lorne Seitz and Terry Doyle from the general membership to review and propose changes to the constitution. Many of the changes proposed are relatively minor format or wording modifications to improve the clarity of the document. Several more significant changes are also being proposed. Reviewing and making revisions one by one would be unnecessarily time consuming and onerous on the membership at the club's Annual general Meeting (AGM). Therefore, your executive committee is proposing to replace the existing constitution with the new constitution developed by the sub-committee and supported by the executive committee.

The more significant changes included in the proposed new constitution are:

- Added section 2, which clarifies the purpose of the club.
- In section 5, Powers, added a mechanism for the executive committee to get approval from the membership to make expenditures from surplus funds from prior years.

- In section 6, Procedures for Election of the Executive Committee, included a sub-section to require the make-up of the Executive committee and responsibilities of each member to be posted within four weeks of the AGM.
- In section 7, Meetings of the Executive Committee, clarified what records must be kept and added financial records to the list.
- In section 8, Retirement and Resignation from the Executive Committee, eliminated the two consecutive term limit for a committee member in order to be able to retain people with key skills on the committee.
- In section 9, Officers, added the treasurer and included his responsibilities. We also eliminated the specific duties of sub-committees to enable the captain to form sub-committees in the most effective manner.
- In section 11, General and Extraordinary meetings, reduced the quorum for Extraordinary General Meetings from 50 members to 25, the same as for the Annual General Meeting (AGM).
- In section 12, Notice, replaced the requirement to send out notices by regular post, allowing for email and posting, which are faster and cheaper.
